Dear Parents and Carers,

Following on from last week's letter, there has been no further guidance from the government regarding the next phase on school reopening. Therefore, to ensure safe opening, the school will be extending its Phase 1 provision for a further two weeks from June 15th. This will mean that the current procedures (as detailed in the 20th May re-opening letter) will remain the same.

If your child, falls into one of the designated groups for Phase 1, and you would like them to return at the start of the two week extension (from June 15th), please contact the school office by Tuesday 9th June at 12pm to register your interest. The Phase 1 designated groups remain the same: Nursery, Reception, Year 1, Year 6 as well as parents who are key workers. Once we have received any additional requests, we will inform you on Thursday 11th June what group your child has been placed in.

Please note that the safety measures that we have set are fundamental. We will of course, try and place additional pupils in a familiar classroom with a familiar adult and with pupils of similar age. However, due to pupils needing to be placed in small consistent groups, it is likely that some children starting the extension may not be placed in their usual classroom, not have their usual member/s of staff or not be in their usual friendship group/class.

We are really missing all the children that we are not seeing and know how challenging this is for you and them. We hope that there will be more government guidance and that from June 29th we may be able to offer some provision to the remaining year groups. For this next phase, as we would like to accommodate as many pupils as safely as possible it is inevitable that the provision will change for all groups of children.
