

Dear parents and carers

Thank you for your continued support during the Coronavirus situation. The current government advice is if you have a new continuous cough or high temperature you must stay at home for fourteen days.

The [key new measures](#) that especially affect our school include:

- Everyone should avoid gatherings and crowded places
- If one person in any household has a persistent cough or fever, everyone living there must stay at home for 14 days
- Schools will not be closed for the moment

Given that the school is open and will remain so unless the government tell us otherwise, I wanted to assure you that we are striving to maintain our core purpose of delivering high quality learning experiences.

Regrettably, I have taken the decision to cancel the parent sharing assemblies, Year 3 & 4 productions (25th March & 26th March) and evening parent/teacher consultations (Tuesday 17th March 2020). These events would involve large numbers of people coming into school and being in close proximity. In addition, I have decided that all school trips this term will be cancelled to minimise the contact between our staff, pupils and the community; these are Year 2 on Monday 23rd March, Year 1 Pizza Express Tuesday 24th March and the whole school disco on Thursday 2nd April. Whilst it may be possible to rearrange these events in the summer term, I am sure you will appreciate the fact that we are unable to give you any dates or guarantees at this time.

Parents that have been unable to have their evening consultation at school will receive the consultation notes this week and be given the opportunity to have a telephone consultation with the class teacher next week.
