Sports Week 2025 – w/c 16th June

In two weeks, we will be having our Sports Week. This is an action-packed week where all pupils in all classes will be taking part in a number of Olympic and Paralympic sports. The sports include: goalball, archery, hockey, table tennis, sitting volleyball, football, swimming races, hurdles, long jump, triple jump, javelin, discus, shot put, aquathlon and duathlon. The pupils will be taking part in adapted activities of these sports in their classes throughout the week.

When the pupils take part in the activities, they will be earning points for their House team and at the end of the week, there will be a closing ceremony to award the prestigious Sports Week Cup. In addition, a select number of certificates will be awarded to pupils based on the Olympic and Paralympic values of teamwork, self-belief, passion, determination, respect and honesty.

Sports Day – Wednesday 18th June 2025 – at 1.15pm

As well as the various activities, the pupils will be taking part in races on Wednesday afternoon. We hope that you will be able to join us for the afternoon at 1.15pm and support the children with lots of enthusiasm and your loudest cheers. We will inform you by 11am if the event has to be postponed due to unsettled weather – we will use the Arbor app and the school website. The reserve day will be on Thursday 19th June 2025 at 1.15pm.

During the afternoon, each class will run a flat and a relay race: every pupil will be involved in both races. In addition, all pupils in KS1 and KS2 will have the opportunity to take part in a longer distance race.

The pupils will be competing within their year groups for their House teams. The House team colours are as follows:

Fox	-	Orange

A list of your child's House team will be posted in the classroom window.

Practical arrangements for Sports Day:

- *The school gates will be opened for spectators at 1pm.*

- *The pupils will be taken out onto the field and taken back into classrooms at the end of the event by their teachers, assisted by Y6 pupils. The pupils can then be collected from their classrooms.*
