- 1 School A raises £742. There are seven classes, one in Reception, two in Key stage 1 and four in Key stage 2. The money is split equally between the seven classes. How much does Reception get? Key stage 1? Key stage 2?
 - 2 School B raises £780. There are ten classes, one in Reception, three in Key stage 1 and six in Key stage 2. How much is raised for each stage?
 - 3 School C raises £410. There are five classes, two in the Infants and three in the Juniors. How much is raised for the Infants? The Juniors?
 - 4 School D raises £981. There are nine classes, two in Foundation stage (Nursery and Reception), three in Key stage 1 and four in Key stage 2. How much is raised for each stage?
 - 5 Invent a new school. This school raises £600. Decide how many classes there are in the school and then work out how much money goes to each class and each key stage.

Answers

1. Each class gets £106. Reception gets £106. Key Stage 1 gets £212. Key Stage 2 gets £424.
2. Reception gets £78. Key Stage 1 gets £234. Key Stage 2 gets £468.
3. Infants get £164. Juniors get £246.
4. Foundation Stage gets £218. Key Stage 1 gets £327. Key Stage 2 gets £436.
