

# Joe Biden

Joe Biden is a politician and president of the United States. He was inaugurated as the 46<sup>th</sup> president on 20<sup>th</sup> January 2021.

He served as the 47<sup>th</sup> vice-president to Barack Obama from 2009 to 2017.



## ★ Early Life

He was born on 20<sup>th</sup> November 1942 in Pennsylvania but moved to Delaware when he was still young. His parents were very hard-working and taught him to be tough and to persevere in life.

As a child, Joe Biden had a stammer and had to use his perseverance to manage this. When he was older, he attended the respected Archmere Academy. To help pay for his tuition, Joe Biden cleaned windows and weeded the gardens. He went on to the University of Delaware and then studied law at Syracuse University Law School.

## Career

In 1971, Joe Biden started his own law firm. He became interested in politics and joined the Democratic party.

In 1972, he ran for the United States Senate and became the fifth-youngest US senator in the nation's history. He went on to serve in the Senate until 2009.

## ★ Family Life

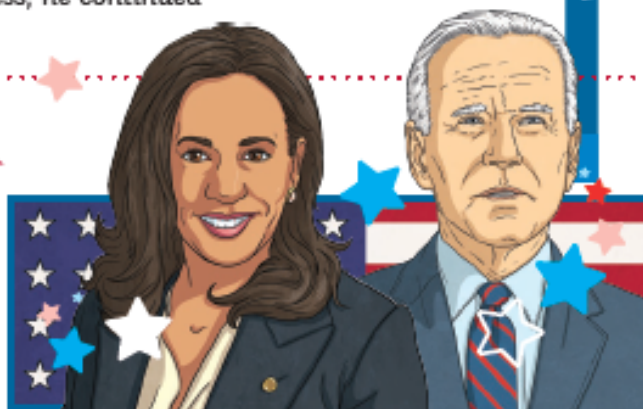
Joe Biden has had to deal with tragedy in his life. In 1972, his wife and young daughter were killed in a car crash. His two sons were badly injured. Joe Biden felt like giving up but found the courage to overcome this adversity.

## Joe Biden

He married again in 1977 and had another daughter. Unfortunately, there was more sadness to come, when in 2015, Joe Biden's eldest son died. Once again, despite his grief and sadness, he continued to think of the people that he served.

### ★ Becoming President

Joe Biden first decided to run for the US presidency in the 1988 election but later dropped out of the election.



In 2008, Joe Biden made his second bid to become president. He was unsuccessful but was chosen as the 47<sup>th</sup> vice-president when Barack Obama became president of the US in 2009.

In 2020, Joe Biden stood as the Democratic candidate against Donald Trump and received a record number of votes. At 78, he is the oldest US president to be sworn into office.

## Glossary

### **adversity:**

A difficult or unpleasant situation.

### **inaugurated:**

Sworn into office at a special ceremony to mark the start of a new presidency.

### **senator:**

A member of the US Senate who passes laws for their country.
