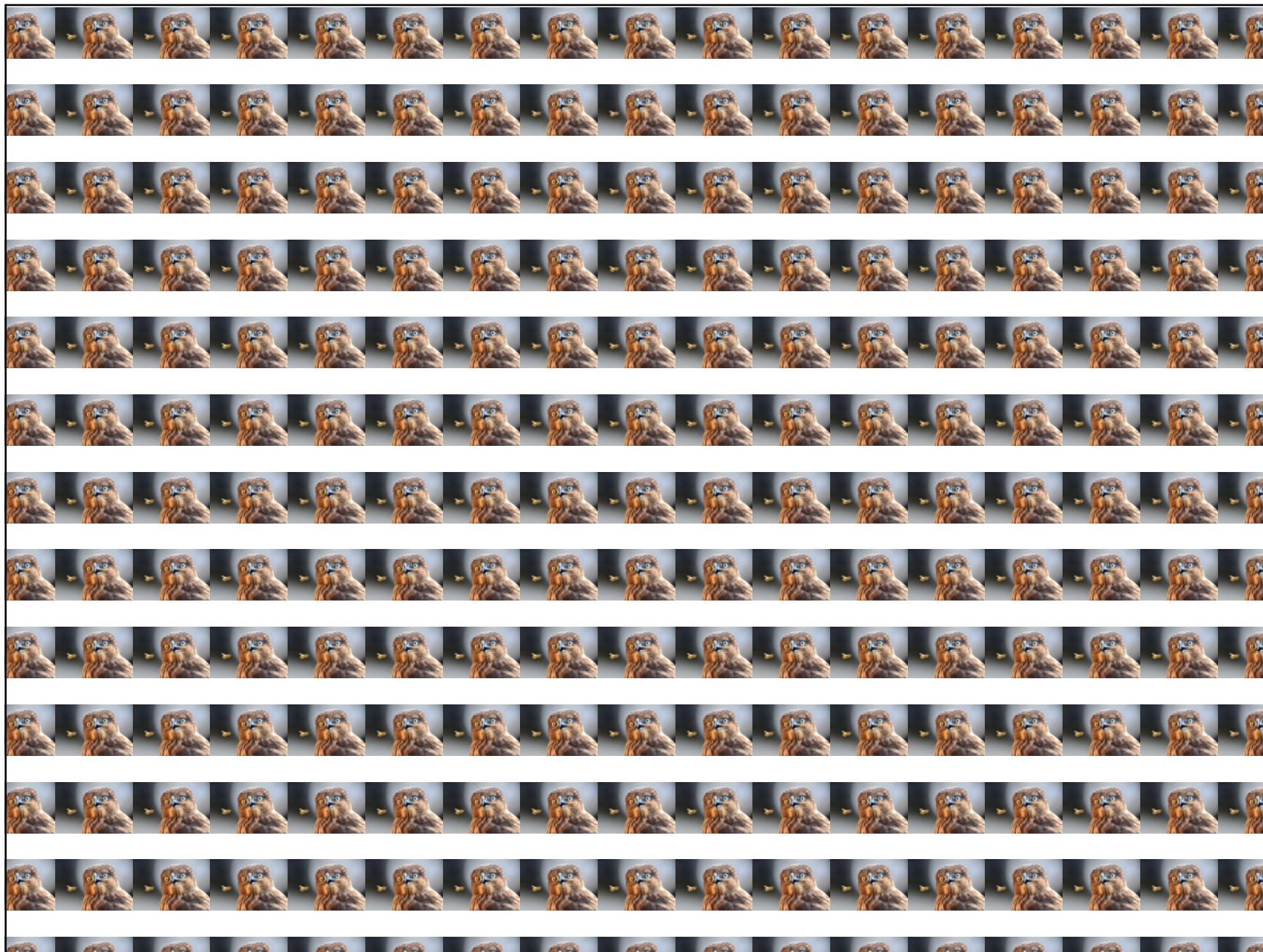

Super Sentences!

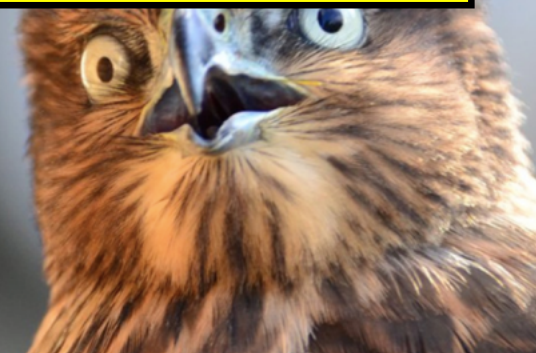
These sentences are definitely NOT super!

The sun shone on the bird's feathers.



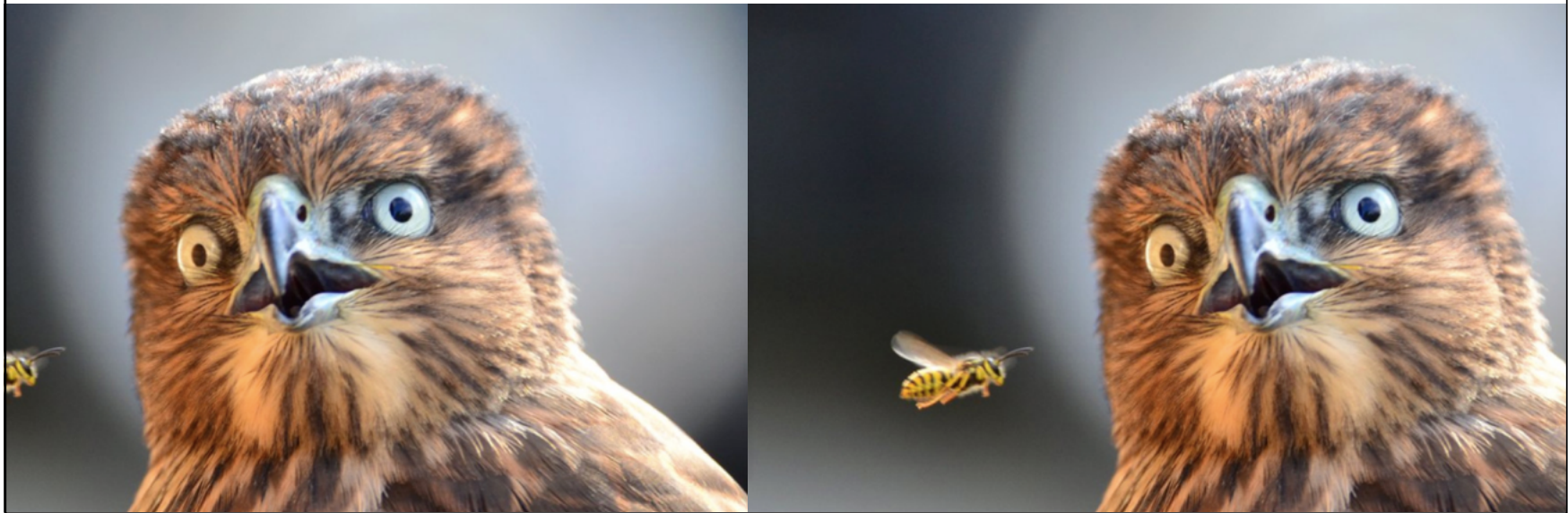
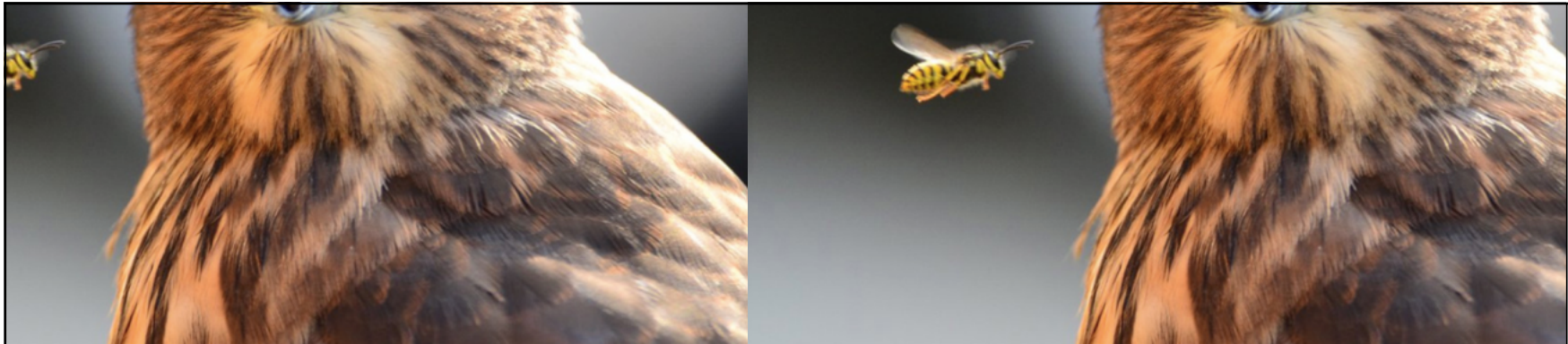
Sentence challenge!

Can you write 3 sentences that contain commas in a list?

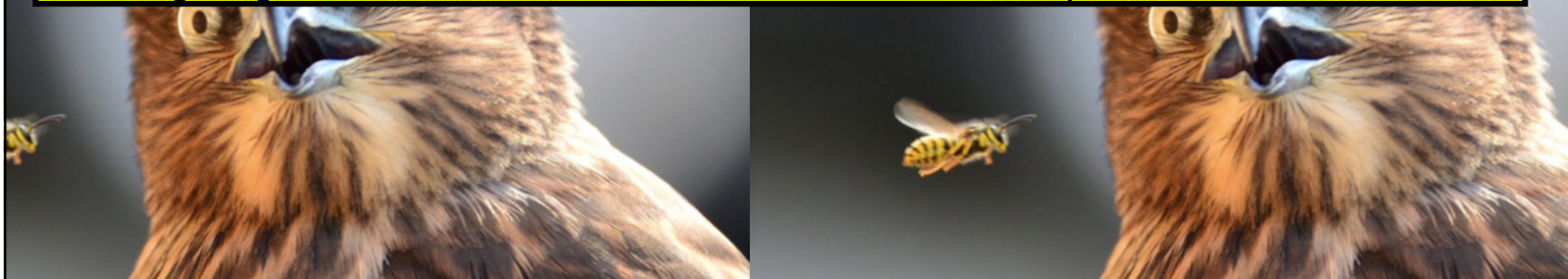

Wide-eyed

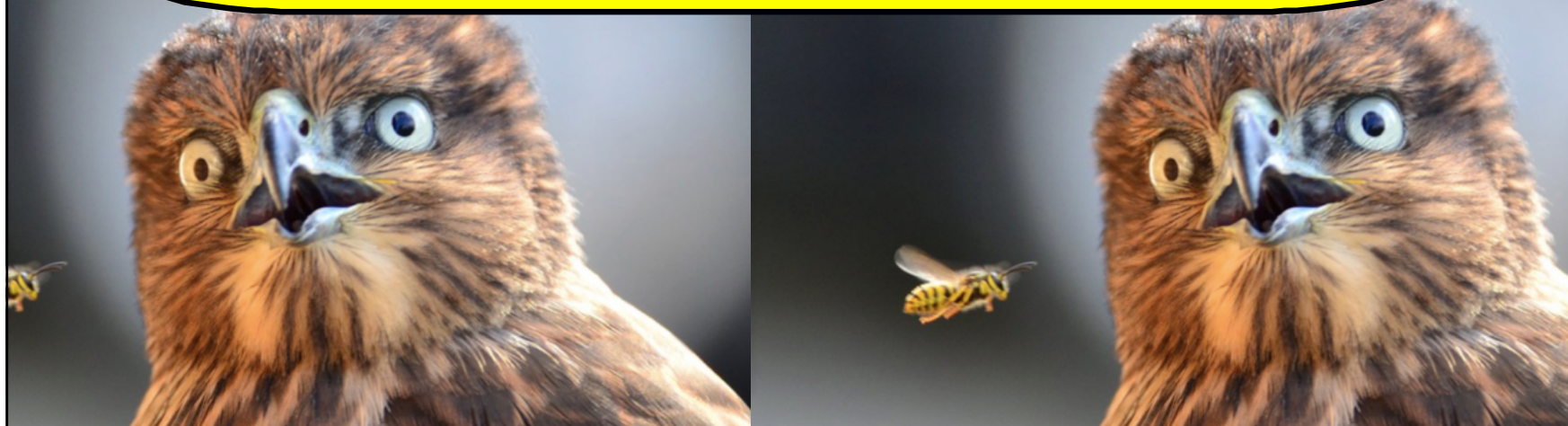

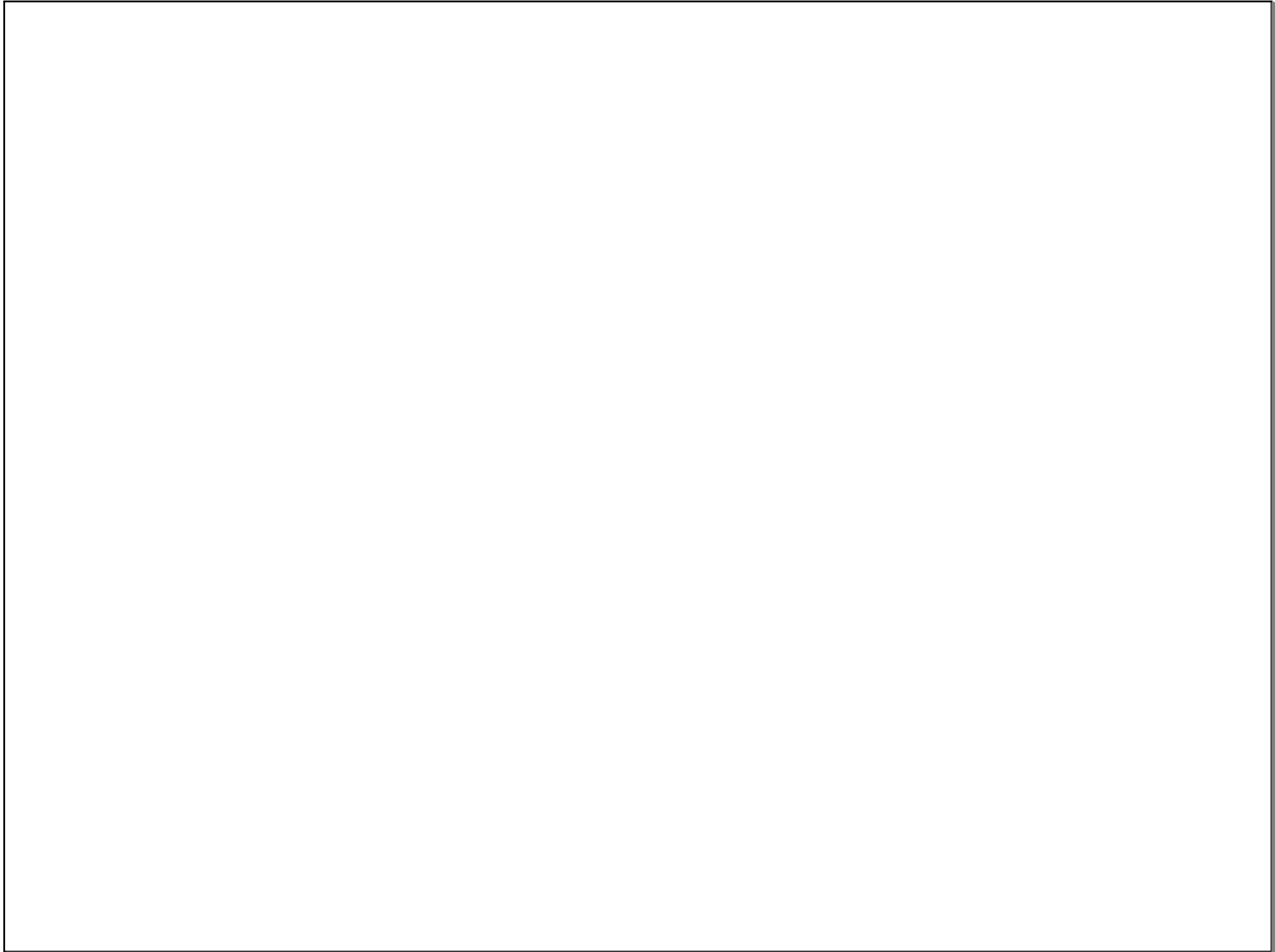
